INTAN JAYA- The serene hills of Pogapa Village in Papua Tengah Province came alive with joy and gratitude on Monday, 20 January 2025, as the inaugural **Free Nutritious Meals (MBG)** program reached the remote Homeyo District. Spearheaded by the Joint Defense Region III Command (Kogabwilhan III)

Commander, **Lieutenant General Bambang Trisnohadi**, the program reflects President Prabowo Subiyanto's vision to improve the health and well-being of the nation's most remote communities.

The initiative, carried out by the TNI Operations Command (Koops) HABEMA, brought smiles to the faces of students, teachers, and residents of Pogapa Inpres Elementary School (SD). The residents and teachers expressed their deep gratitude for the TNI's dedication to their welfare. One of the students, Maria Bagubau, shared her excitement, saying, *"Thank you, Commander. We are happy to eat nutritious food for free. God bless."*

Lieutenant General Bambang Trisnohadi reflected on the significance of this event, stating, *"The Koops HABEMA initiative to implement the MBG program at Pogapa Elementary School is a testament to the TNI's commitment to serving the government's vision of meeting basic community needs, supporting the acceleration of development in Papua."*
